# One New Jersey Lottery Ticket Wins \$100,000 One Other New Jersey Ticket Wins \$50,000 

TRENTON (Nov. 30, 2020) - Two New Jersey Lottery tickets matched four of the five white balls and the Powerball drawn for the Wednesday, November 25, drawing winning the $\mathbf{\$ 5 0 , 0 0 0}$ third-tier prize. One of those tickets was purchased with Power Play, multiplying the prize to $\mathbf{\$ 1 0 0 , 0 0 0}$. The winning tickets from Wednesday night's drawing were sold at the following locations:

- Bergen County (\$100,000): 7-Eleven \#18390, 300 Hackensack St., Wood Ridge; and
- Monmouth County (\$50,000): Hazlet Shoprite \#626, 3120 Route 35, Hazlet.

The winning numbers for the Wednesday, November 25, drawing were: 02, 57, 58, 60, and $\mathbf{6 5}$. The Red Power Ball number was 26. The Multiplier number was $\mathbf{0 2}$. 29,806 New Jersey players took home an estimated $\$ 148,139$ in prizes ranging from $\$ 4$ to $\$ 200$.
